BIO

Alex Ebstein expands upon her work transforming yoga mats and powder coated metal into images of eyes, curves, limbs - literal and abstracted. Figments and artifacts of glamour and group fitness hover over tactile surfaces, embellished with embroidery, acrylic and other materials. In a world mediated through social media, aspiration and intention mingle with the dreamy, indulgent space of diary, time capsule and stasis. As the ways in which we interact are interrupted and reexamined, constraining pressures such as female competition and trends in health and beauty become flimsy symbols disengaged from their power to divide.
