BIO

Deeply rooted in oral storytelling, particularly ghost stories passed down through the women in her family, Langdon Graves' work is an exploration of our perennial fascination with the occult and supernatural beliefs, and their complex relationship to grief and trauma. Her playful, soft color palette and domestic imagery are a peculiar contrast to the works' darker symbolism, further blurring the line between the unnatural and the ordinary. Borrowing elements of vanitas and memento mori painting, the familiar elements of art history and everyday life move in and out of logical arrangements like the shifting nature of the mind in its attempts to reconstruct the past, or comprehend the supernatural.
